RECORD PRICES FOR TOP GOODS AT FUR HARVESTERS AUCTION

March 21 – 22, 2013 marked the most successful sale in FHA history, surpassing the previous record set just last March. Buying support was widespread, and while China dominated, there was excellent support from Greece, Russia, Ukraine, Italy and Korea. Record top lot prices were achieved on sable, fisher, and lynx cat, highlighting the increasing demand for luxury goods.

Compared to March 2012, most items advanced significantly. Wild mink averaged \$34.37, an increase of 30% over last season. Otter showed continued strength averaging \$104.50.

Raccoon from all sections showed increased prices with a first section average of \$27.30, and a top of \$110.00.

Muskrats showed continued strength with an overall average of \$11.75 and a top price of \$32.00. We expect continued strength in the market for the spring collection of muskrats.

Beaver continues to be a concern due to dressing issues but larger sizes and heavier goods brought good prices, leading to an average of \$32.68 and a top of \$200.00. Clearances on all of the foregoing species were excellent.

Red fox displayed its continuing popularity, selling for an average price of \$67.58 and a top price of \$310.00. Arctic fox averaged \$61.26, while grey fox averaged \$35.62.

FHA has firmly established itself as the primary source for luxury wild fur, with the year's highest averages anywhere and record top prices being established on some species. Fisher averaged \$158.01 and a stellar top price of \$750.00. FHA's premium collection of lynx averaged \$203.64, with a top price of \$1,050.00.

An amazing sable sale led to strength in all sections with an overall average of \$148.37, and an all time record price of \$1,300.00 for the top lot.

The finest collection of western lynx cats in the world saw 60 lots selling for over \$1,000.00 each leading to an overall western average of \$674.09 and the year's highest top lot at \$3,200.00.

FHA's international wild fur promotional efforts in China and elsewhere continue to bear fruit. FHA offers thanks once again to our loyal shippers and the international trade for another record setting performance. We expect continued strength in the market for our next sale, which will be held on May 19 and 20.
