Fur Harvesters online auction concluded at 17:00 Eastern Time April 2nd, 2020. The COVID-19 virus had made it impossible to stand our ground and follow through with our scheduled March auction set to be held in Toronto. All the major countries we depend on to purchase our product were and continue to be locked down. This left us only two options one of which was to cancel, meaning our shippers would not get paid and this was not an option for us. Our team developed and employed an online auction system in less than a week, which in itself was to be commended. The system was only available for REGISTERED BUYERS and all species were valued based on last May's FHA levels with thresholds protecting all lots. These thresholds at times varied within a species, allowing a greater or lesser percentage depending on the section or grade.

Going into this it was apparent that the odds were very much against us in hopes of having this auction conclude with a strong overall clearance. Many wild fur articles are so varied that to expect buyers to take strong positions and bid on large quantities of goods sight unseen was not realistic. In the case of Lynx, Lynx Cat and top Western Coyotes, Italy is very dominant and we knew it would be hard to sell any quantity of these at this time with Italy being so drastically impacted by COVID-19. Korea is in the same situation and we are heavily dependent on this country for our sable. We continue to sell quite steadily now with Private Treaty while maintaining the same thresholds set out in the online auction catalog. The shining star during this online auction was from the North American buying community which really came through in articles such as beaver, quality raccoon and eastern coyotes. China also took a very active role in muskrats, commercial raccoon and coyotes. We have protected the best goods and these will be held to our values until Private Treaty is closed and will be consigned to our next auction.

All of us here at FHA are proud to deliver the following results which surpassed our expectations. We did our best to stand and deliver during these difficult and troubling times and look forward to scheduling a traditional auction in September, permitting the current situation passes.

We will update the sales results as PT sales transpire. Until such time I wish safe harbor to all of our shippers and buyers and their families, and GOD BLESS.

OUR NEXT AUCTION has been set for August 16 through 22.

Last receiving day in North Bay is June 7. We advise all shippers to frequent the FHA website for scheduled fur pickup routes that will be posted as they become available.
